



Baby Hoodie

This funky double breasted hooded jacket will keep your favorite small human all toasty.

0-3 months - 250g

3-6 months - 280g

6-9 months - 350g

9-12 months - 380g

Needles: 4.00mm

Tension: 22 stitches & 48 rows to 4 Inches using garter stitch on 4.00mm needles

Yarn: Light Worsted/DK/8PLY

Other: 4 Buttons

Back

With 4.00mm needles cast on 53 (57,63,67) stitches

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) till piece measures 4.75 (5.5, 6, 6.25) inches from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Back Cont...

Bind off 4 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows.

45 (49,55,59) Stitches remaining.

Continue until piece measures 8.25 (9.5, 10.25, 11) inches from cast on edge, ending with wrong side row.

Bind off 11 (12,14,15) stitches next 2 rows & place remaining 23 (25, 27, 29) stitches on holder for joining hood.

Alternate Finishing:

Place the 2 lots of 11 (12,14,15) stitches onto a holder & do the 3 needle bind off with the front piece stitches to give yourself a lovely smooth shoulder seam.

Left Front:

With 4.00mm needles cast on 38 (41 ,45, 48) stitches.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) till piece measures 4.75 (5.5, 6, 6.25) inches from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off 4 stitches at beginning of next row.

Continue until piece measures 8.25 (9.5, 10.25, 11) inches from cast on edge, ending with wrong side row.

Bind off 11 (12,14,15) stitches & place remaining 23 (25, 27, 29) stitches on holder for joining hood.

Alternate Finishing:

If you have decided to do the 3 needle bind off then place 11 (12,14,15) stitches onto holder instead of binding off.

Right Front:

With 4.00mm needles cast on 38 (41 ,45, 48) stitches.

Work in garter stitch till piece measures 3 (3.5, 3.5) Inches from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Right Front Cont...

Button Hole row: Knit 3 stitches, YO, K2Tog, Knit 13 (15, 17, 19) K2Tog, YO, Knit to the end. Continue until piece measures 4.75 (5.5, 6, 6.25) inches from cast on edge, ending with a right side row.

Cast off 4 stitches at beginning of next row.

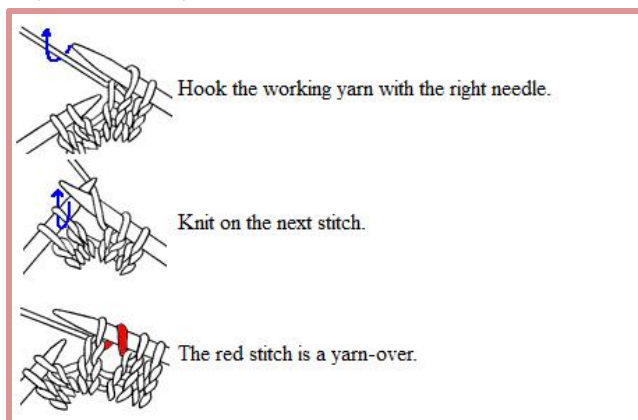
Continue until piece measures 5 (6, 6.25, 6.75) inches from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Make another buttonhole row.

Continue until piece measures 8.25 (9.5, 10.25, 11) inches from cast on edge, ending at armhole.

Bind off 11 (12,14,15) stitches & place remaining 23 (25, 27, 29) stitches on holder for joining hood.

YO = Yarn Over



SEW SHOULDER SEAMS – or join with 3 needle bind off.

3 Needle Bind Off

Step 1: Take the two pieces of knitting and place them right sides facing each other. (1 use DPNs)

Step 2: Take a third needle and slide it into the first stitch “knit-wise” on the needle closest to you.

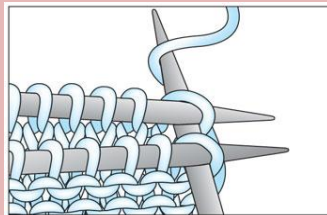
Step 3: Take the third needle and slide it into the first stitch “knit-wise” on the second needle.

Step 4: Wrap the working yarn around the third needle.

Step 5: Pull the stitch through both stitches.
(as if they are one stitch)

Step 6: Pull the stitches off the two needles creating one on the third needle. (repeat once)

Step 7: Take the first stitch on the third needle and slip it over the second. (like a normal bind off.)



Hood:

With right side facing & 4.00mm needles pick up and knit the 23 (25, 27, 29) stitches from the right front, the 23 (25, 27, 29) stitches from the back, increasing evenly add an extra 11 (12, 13, 15) stitches, and the 23 (25, 27, 29) stitches from the left front. A total of 80 (87, 94, 102) stitches. Work in garter stitch till hood measures 7 (8, 8.5, 9.5) Inches from joining row. Bind off traditional way or use the 3 needle bind off (see finishing notes)

Sleeves:

With 4.00mm needles cast on 29 (31, 33, 35) stitches

Work in garter stitch for 25 (25, 33, 33) rows.

Increase one stitch each end of next row and every 8th row until there is a total of 41 (45, 49, 53) stitches .

Work in garter stitch without further increasing until piece measures 7.5 (8.25, 9.5, 10.25) inches from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Bind off.

Finishing:

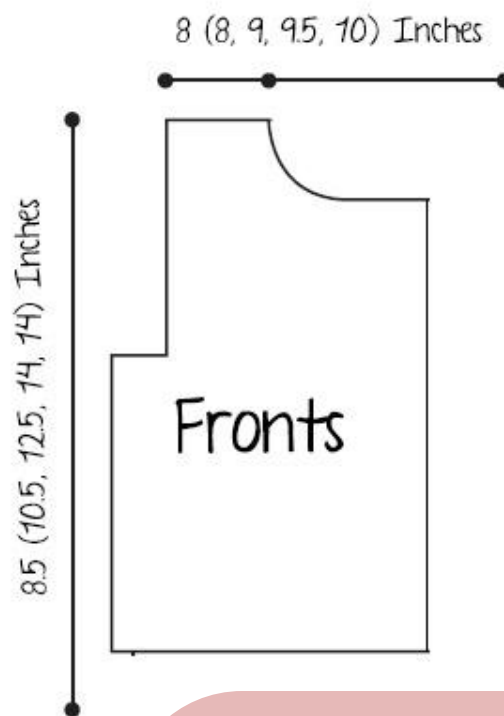
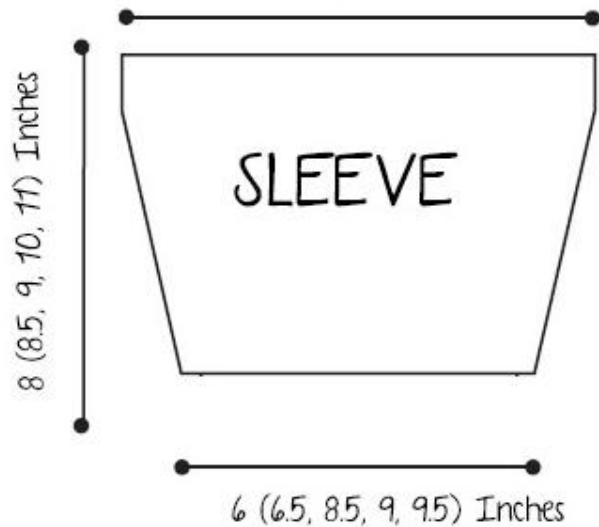
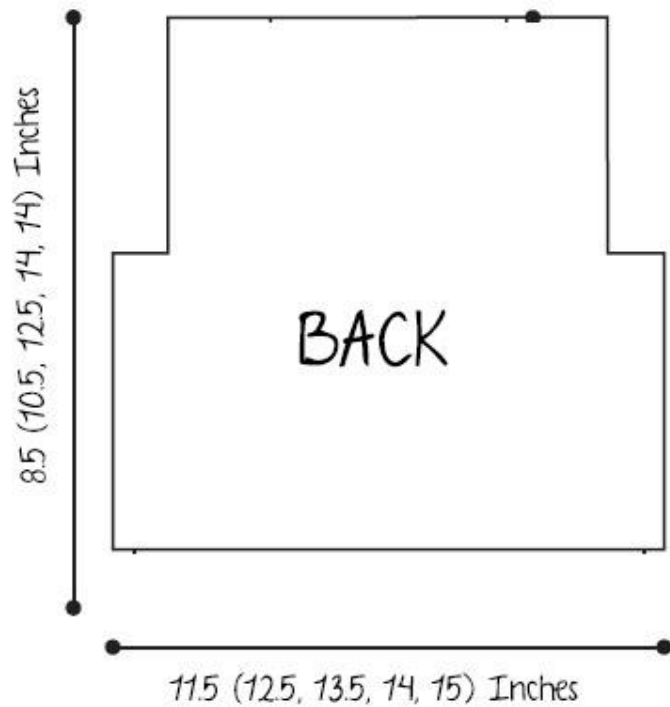
Place half the stitches from each half of hood on DPNs & use 3 needle bind off, being careful to make sure the seam will be on the inside of the hood. If using traditional bind off, fold hood in half & seam along.

Sew in sleeves.

Sew on 4 buttons, matching them up to opposing buttonholes.

Optional: Fold back hood a small way & sew to hold in place.

Add tassel to peak of hood.



K2TOG

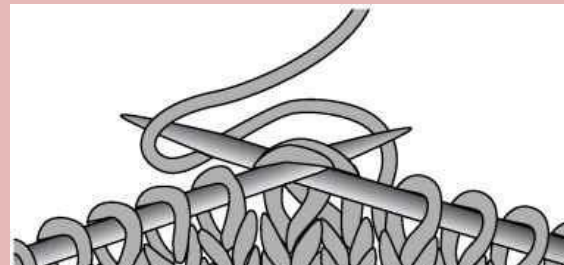
Step 1: Place the right hand needle under the second stitch of the left needle, as if you are going to knit.

Step 2: Slide the right hand needle through both stitches, behind the left hand needle.

Step 3: Wrap the yarn around the right hand needle as if you are knitting.

Step 4:

Knit the two stitches together with the right hand needle, and pull them off the left hand needle.



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
